3.0 Community Updates

3.1 – Dr. Corey Jackson Assemblymember District Representative – Jorge Zavala

- Events – free expungement clinic at mead valley community center May 29, family law only, no criminal cases.

- Scholarship opportunities available for seniors in high school or college freshmen deadline is May 16.

- Reach out for disability or VA assistance.

3.2 – Riverside County Sheriff's Department – Capt. Kevin Lamb / Deputy Thomas

- 233 calls for service for area, 4 assaults, 2 thefts, and 2 stolen vehicles, 8 arrests for weapons, warrants, and domestic violence

- 6,402 calls for all of Perris Station

3.3 – California Highway Patrol [Invited] - ABSENT

3.4 – Riverside County Fire Department – Fire Station #9 – Fire Captain James Worthington

- 150 calls for service: 11 fires, 76 medical aids, 3 traffic collisions, 25 other calls like alarms or public assist.

3.5 – Code Enforcement – District 1 Supervisor, Shane Hidey

- Call Code Enforcement for all illegal dumping.

- 24 new open cases, closed 12 cases, 250 cases, one case is a scrapyard operating illegally off hwy-74, they have 3 weeks to remove things of the property.

- Club drive: process in removing RV from property.

3.6 – Animal Services – Commander of Field Services, Josh Sisler / Kyle Stephens

- March: 21 cruelty, 280 calls of service, 9 citations, 81 dead animals

- April: 12 bites, 18 possible animal cruelty, 268 initial calls for service, 122 animals were

impounded.

3.7 –Emergency Management Department– Emergency Management Program Supervisor, Eric Cadden

- Rivcoready.org sign up for Alert RivCo!
- The purpose of EMD is to tell different county depts on what to do during an emergency
- Local hazard mitigation plan, we cannot be reimbursed for funds used in emergency
