## 3.0 Public Safety Updates

3.1 - Riverside County Sheriff's Department – Capt. Brandon Ford/Lt. Edward Chavez

- Perris Station has a public Service Announcement bulletin to visit and post comments
- Arrest made for an ongoing car theft.
- Scam alert: Someone impersonating a Deputy making calls and advising that there is a bench warrant and to pay money to avoid arrest. This is a scam. Do not provide personal information
- Holiday approaching: Keep residence safe by turning on alarms.
- Double homicide is still being investigated

3.2 - Riverside County Fire Department – Fire Station #59/Capt. Shawn Arnold

- Stats for October : 177 calls, 116 Medical, 19 traffic, 16 fires, 26n other misc. calls
- Holiday/Winter season Safety Tips: Be cautious when cooking on the stove top. Keep it clean. Be careful of wet roads and fog. Emergency preparedness makes sure have emergency supplies.
- Time change November 6, 2016. Change batteries in smoke detectors, Co2 Monitor
- Captain Arnold- Warming fires in a controlled environment are permitted with a permit. There is still a burn suspension Riverside County.

- Downtown Riverside Station RTZ Route 54 is a free shuttle from the downtown Riverside Station. RCTC will run metro link “festival of lights” train to increase riders
- Dial A ride plus service for disables and seniors has been expanded to two and three quarter miles from a RTA stop
