Good morning Ladies and Gentlemen,

I know all of you have fielded constituent inquiries regarding the upcoming April 10th property tax delinquent date. I wanted to inform you that we have been in discussion with the State and our Association regarding the impact of COVID-19. Although the delinquent date has not been extended, the Treasurer-Tax Collector is now confident in our legal authority and ability to waive penalties and costs due to late payment of these taxes for those that are impacted directly, either physically or financially, due to quarantine, illness, loss of job, or the closure of a personal business. Upon the request of the taxpayer and late submittal of the payment, documentation will be required to ensure the situation is related to the COVID-19 pandemic. We will examine these cases on an individual basis, however when the original base amount of the late payment is made and documentation is provided and appears to be in order, we will exercise our authority and waive any penalties, interest and costs associated with the late payment. This information can be provided to any of your constituents that contact you in regard to this situation or you can simply refer them to our office as we are responding to phone calls, emails, and written correspondence.
